

MICROSOFT SOFTWARE LICENSE TERMS FOR A VIRTUAL HARD DISK (VHD) IMAGE OF MICROSOFT DYNAMICS AX AND THE MICROSOFT PRODUCTS IDENTIFIED IN EXHIBIT A

These license terms are an agreement between Microsoft Corporation (or based on where you live, one of its affiliates) and you. Please read them. They apply to the software named above, which includes the media on which you received it, if any. This agreement also apply to any Microsoft

- update,
- supplements,
- Internet-based services, and
- support services

for this software, unless other terms accompany those items. If so, those terms apply.

Microsoft provides the software to assist developers and independent software vendors in creating their programs or applications for use with Microsoft Dynamics AX cloud ERP service (the “**Microsoft Dynamics Service**”).

BY INSTALLING, HAVING INSTALLED, DOWNLOADING, HAVING DOWNLOADED, ACCESSING, OR USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU ACCEPT THIS AGREEMENT. IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT THIS AGREEMENT, DO NOT INSTALL, HAVE INSTALLED, ACCESS, OR USE THE SOFTWARE. If an individual enters into this agreement on behalf of a legal entity, that individual represents that he or she has the authority to bind that entity to this agreement.

AS DESCRIBED BELOW, USING SOME FEATURES ALSO OPERATES AS YOUR CONSENT TO THE TRANSMISSION OF CERTAIN STANDARD COMPUTER INFORMATION FOR INTERNET-BASED SERVICES.

If you comply with this agreement, you have the rights below. This agreement supersedes the terms of any Microsoft software license term agreement that you may encounter in the software or otherwise on the VHD image. The Exceptions and Additional Terms for Particular Products are included in Exhibit A.

1. ACCESS AND USE RIGHTS.

- a. VHD Formats.** You may use the VHD formats, including Microsoft Virtual PC or Microsoft Virtual Server.
- b. Pre-Release Code.** The software may include code marked as “pre-release”, “preview” or similar designation. You may use the pre-release code only in a development, test, or demo environment for the software. The pre-release code is not for use with the software in a live operating environment. Your use of any pre-release code is governed by the software license terms located here: <http://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkId=733561>.
- b. Development, Testing, and Demo Use.**

- You may install, copy, and use any number of copies of the software on any number of devices that are owned or controlled by your organization solely to (i) test the software; (ii) design, develop, and test sample programs that you create (“your sample programs”) for the Microsoft Dynamics Service; and (iii) demonstrate and internally evaluate your sample programs with the Microsoft Dynamics Service. **You may not use the software or your sample programs in a live operating environment.**
 - You may modify the source and object form of any model files marked as “sample” and incorporate the modified code into your sample programs.
 - You may upload your sample programs solely to the computer systems where we host the Microsoft Dynamics Service to test, use, demonstrate, and evaluate your sample programs.
 - You may not distribute your sample programs or any model files marked as “sample” or similar designation, or use any of these in a live operating environment.
- c. License Keys.** You may be permitted to access certain features or functionality in the software enabled by a license key (“License Key”) that Microsoft includes in the software. You may use the License Key, but only:
- internally within, and for running, your organization’s business operations, and
 - on your organization’s device(s) on which the Microsoft Dynamics Modern Point of Sale (MPOS) application is installed.
- You may not (i) share the License Key with, or otherwise provide access to the License Key by, any third party; or (ii) install and use any License Key on any device that is not owned or controlled by your organization.
- d. Binary Packages.** The software may produce “Binary Packages” of code with an “.axpackage” extension that incorporates both your sample programs and Microsoft code. You may use such Microsoft code only in the form of the Binary Packages as produced by the software. You may not extract such Microsoft code from the Binary Packages or use such Microsoft code other than in the process of running your sample programs on the Microsoft Dynamics Service.
- e. Icons and Templates.** You may copy icons or templates included in the software and incorporate the copies in your sample programs solely for use with the software and the Microsoft Dynamics Services.
- f. Images.** You may: (i) copy the images and animations (“Images”) included in the software and incorporate the copies in your sample programs for use solely with the Microsoft Dynamics Services; (ii) manipulate, blend, crop or modify the Images to make adjustments to the size, color, brightness or contrast as necessary to optimize your sample programs; and (iii) incorporate such modified Images into your sample programs and use such modified Images solely in the software and the Microsoft Dynamics Service.
- g. Modifications.** Microsoft is not responsible for any problems that result from modifications
- made by or for you or by a third party, or that are caused by third party hardware or software; or
 - caused by any features or services you or any third party include or use with the software or your sample programs, such as features that connect to any third party computer systems over the Internet or any other Internet-based service.

2. INTERNET-BASED SERVICES. Microsoft may provide Internet-based services with the software. It may change or cancel them at any time. If Internet-based services are included within the software, they are typically simulated for demo purposes in the VHD image and no transmission over the Internet takes place. However, should the VHD image be configured to transmit over the Internet the following terms apply:

- a. Consent for Internet-Based Services.** The software features described below and in the Windows Server Privacy Highlights connect to Microsoft's or a service provider's computer systems over the Internet. In some cases, you will not receive a separate notice when they connect. You may switch off these features or not use them. For more information about these features, go to go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?linkid=101128. BY USING THESE FEATURES, YOU CONSENT TO THE TRANSMISSION OF THIS INFORMATION. Microsoft does not use the information to identify or contact you.
- **Computer Information.** The following features use Internet protocols, which send to the appropriate systems computer information, such as your Internet protocol address, the type of operating system, browser and name and version of the software you are using, and the language code of the device where you run the software. Microsoft uses this information to make the Internet-based services available to you.
 - Plug and Play and Plug and Play Extensions. You may connect new hardware to your device, either directly or over a network. Your device may not have the drivers needed to communicate with that hardware. If so, the update feature of the software can obtain the correct driver from Microsoft and install it on your device. An administrator can disable this update feature.
 - Windows Update Feature. You may connect new hardware to the device where you run the software. Your device may not have the drivers needed to communicate with that hardware.  - Auto Root Update. The Auto Root Update feature updates the list of trusted certificate authorities. You can switch off the Auto Root Update feature.
 - Windows Media Player. When you use Windows Media Player, it checks with Microsoft for
 - compatible online music services in your region;
 - new versions of the player; and
 - codecs if your device does not have the correct ones for playing content.

- Windows Media Digital Rights Management. Content owners use Windows Media digital rights management technology (WMDRM) to protect their intellectual property, including copyrights. The software and third party software use WMDRM to play and copy WMDRM-protected content. If the software fails to protect the content, content owners may ask Microsoft to revoke the software's ability to use WMDRM to play or copy protected content. Revocation does not affect other content. When you download licenses for protected content, you agree that Microsoft may include a revocation list with the licenses. Content owners may require you to upgrade WMDRM to access their content. Microsoft software that includes WMDRM will ask for your consent prior to the upgrade. If you decline an upgrade, you will not be able to access content that requires the upgrade. You may switch off WMDRM features that access the Internet. When these features are off, you can still play content for which you have a valid license.
- Malicious Software Removal. During setup, if you select "Get important updates for installation", the software may check and remove certain malware from your device. "Malware" is malicious software. If the software runs, it will remove the Malware listed and updated at www.support.microsoft.com/?kbid=890830. During a Malware check, a report will be sent to Microsoft with specific information about Malware detected, errors, and other information about your device. This information is used to improve the software and other Microsoft products and services. No information included in these reports will be used to identify or contact you. You may disable the software's reporting functionality by following the instructions found at www.support.microsoft.com/?kbid=890830. - Network Awareness. This feature determines whether a system is connected to a network by either passive monitoring of network traffic or active DNS or HTTP queries. The query only transfers standard TCP/IP or DNS information for routing purposes. You can switch off the active query feature through a registry setting.
- Windows Time Service. This service synchronizes with time.windows.com once a week to provide your computer with the correct time. You can turn this feature off or choose your preferred time source within the Date and Time Control Panel applet. The connection uses standard NTP protocol.
- IPv6 Network Address Translation (NAT) Traversal service (Teredo). This feature helps existing home Internet gateway devices transition to IPv6. IPv6 is a next generation Internet protocol. It helps enable end-to-end connectivity often needed by peer-to-peer applications. To do so, each time you start up the software the Teredo client service will attempt to locate a public Teredo Internet service. It does so by sending a query over the Internet. This query only transfers standard Domain Name Service information to determine if your computer is connected to the Internet and can locate a public Teredo service. If you
 - use an application that needs IPv6 connectivity or
 - configure your firewall to always enable IPv6 connectivity

by default standard Internet Protocol information will be sent to the Teredo service at Microsoft at regular intervals. No other information is sent to Microsoft. You can change this default to use non-

Microsoft servers. You can also switch off this feature using a command line utility named "netsh".

- Windows Rights Management Services. The software contains a feature that allows you to create content that cannot be printed, copied or sent to others without your permission. For more information, go to www.microsoft.com/rms. You may choose not to use this feature.
 - Accelerators. When you click on or move your mouse over an Accelerator, the title and full web address or URL of the current webpage, as well as standard computer information, and any content you have selected, might be sent to the service provider. - b. **Use of Information.** Microsoft may use the computer information, Accelerator information, CEIP information, search suggestions information, and Malware reports to improve our software and services. We may also share it with others, such as hardware and software vendors. They may use the information to improve how their products run with Microsoft software.
- c. **Misuse of Internet-based Services.** You may not use these services in any way that could harm them or impair anyone else's use of them. You may not use the services to try to gain unauthorized access to any service, data, account or network by any means.
- 3. TIME-SENSITIVE SOFTWARE.** The software will stop running on the date indicated in Exhibit A. You will not receive any other notice. You may not be able to access data used with the software when it stops running.
- 4. MANDATORY ACTIVATION.** Activation associates the use of the software with a specific device. If you are prompted to activate the software while you are evaluating the software, during activation the software will send information about the software and the device to Microsoft. This information includes the version, language and product key of the software, the Internet protocol address of the device, and information derived from the hardware configuration of the device. - 10. SCOPE OF LICENSE.** The software is licensed, not sold. It is licensed as a single piece of software. You may not separate its component parts. This agreement only gives you some rights to use the software. Microsoft reserves all other rights. Unless applicable law gives you more rights despite this limitation, you may use the software only as expressly permitted in this agreement. In doing so, you must comply with any technical limitations in the software that only allow you to use it in certain ways. You may not

- work around any technical limitations in the software;
- reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the software, or otherwise attempt to derive the source code for the software, except and solely to the extent: (i) expressly permitted by applicable law, despite this limitation; or (ii) required to debug changes to any libraries licensed under the GNU Lesser General Public License which are included with and linked to by the software;
- use the software's files and components within another operating system or application running on another operating system;
- make more copies of the software than specified in this agreement or allowed by applicable law, despite this limitation;
- publish the software for others to copy;
- distribute, rent, lease, or lend the software;
- transfer the software or this agreement to any third party; or
- use the software for commercial software hosting services.

11. EXPORT RESTRICTIONS. The software is subject to United States export laws and regulations. You must comply with all domestic and international export laws and regulations that apply to the software. These laws include restrictions on destinations, end users and end use. The laws of the state where you live govern all other claims, including claims under state consumer protection laws, unfair competition laws, and in tort.
- Outside the United States.** If you acquired the software in any other country, the laws of that country apply.

15. LEGAL EFFECT. This agreement describes certain legal rights. You may have other rights under the laws of your country. You may also have rights with respect to the party from whom you acquired the software. This agreement does not change your rights under the laws of your country if the laws of your country do not permit it to do so.

This limitation applies to

- anything related to the software, services, content (including code) on third party Internet sites, or third party programs; and
- claims for breach of contract, breach of warranty, guarantee or condition, strict liability, negligence, or other tort to the extent permitted by applicable law.

This will reset the grace period for 10 days and then you may connect the virtual machine to the Internet and reactivate it for an additional 180 evaluation period.</p>
